

DRESS CODE

The following Dress Code was established to meet the California Educational Code. Students are expected to wear clothes that meet acceptable standards in safety, health, and neatness. Extremes in dress or grooming that cause undue attention or become a disruptive influence on the campus are not allowed. Our hope is that when a student leaves for school in the morning their family will be pleased with the student's appearance.

- **Shorts and skirts**
 - **Shorts and/or skirts should be mid-thigh or longer.**
 - ***Please Note: that leggings may be worn underneath shorts that are too short.***
- **Ripped/torn pants**
 - **If excessively large holes are above mid-thigh, then leggings should be worn underneath the pants/shorts.**
- **Sagging**
 - **Sagging pants/shorts are not allowed at school.**
 - **Pants/shorts must fit and be no more than one size larger than waist. Undergarments must be covered.**
 - ***Please Note: wearing gym shorts under sagging pants/shorts does not make them acceptable at school.***
 - **Belt ends may not hang down.**
- **Shirts**
 - **Clothes shall appropriately conceal both the mid-section or stomach area as well as undergarments at all times.**
 - **Strapless, halter and off the shoulder shirts/dresses are not acceptable for school and will not be allowed on campus regardless of what is worn underneath.**
 - **“Muscle shirts” are not allowed. Shirts, tank tops, etc. with excessively large arm holes are not acceptable.**
 - **Shirts are to be buttoned when worn.**
- **Shoes**
 - **Shoes must be worn and considered safe at all times.**
 - **All sandals must have back straps. “Flip-flops” (or the like) are not allowed.**
 - ***P.E. Classes: shoes must have a soft sole, completely cover the foot and fit well. No “Ugg” like boots.***
- **Hats**
 - **“Chipman” beanies are the only hats allowed to be worn on campus**
 - **Headgear of any kind is not allowed at school.**
 - ***Please note: During the cold months, students may wear the hood from their jackets or sweatshirts to keep them warm.***
- **Pajamas and/or slippers**
 - **Pajamas or pajama like clothing is not allowed at school.**
 - **Slippers are never allowed at school.**
- **Clothing, jewelry, and personal items (backpacks, buttons, water bottles, bracelets, lanyards, etc.) shall be free of writing, pictures and any other insignia/s that:**
 - **are crude, vulgar, profane or sexually suggestive**

- **have drug, alcohol or tobacco company advertising, promotions, the likenesses or the use of such products**
- **promote or glorify illegal and/or gang related activities including, but not limited to:**
 - **drugs**
 - **tagging**
 - **weapons**
- **encourage discrimination against others on the basis of race, ancestry, national origin, color, religion, ethnic group, sex, age, sexual discrimination, marital or parental status, physical or mental disability or the perception of one or more of such characteristics.**
