Daylight savings time **affords** us more time to play outside before it gets dark.

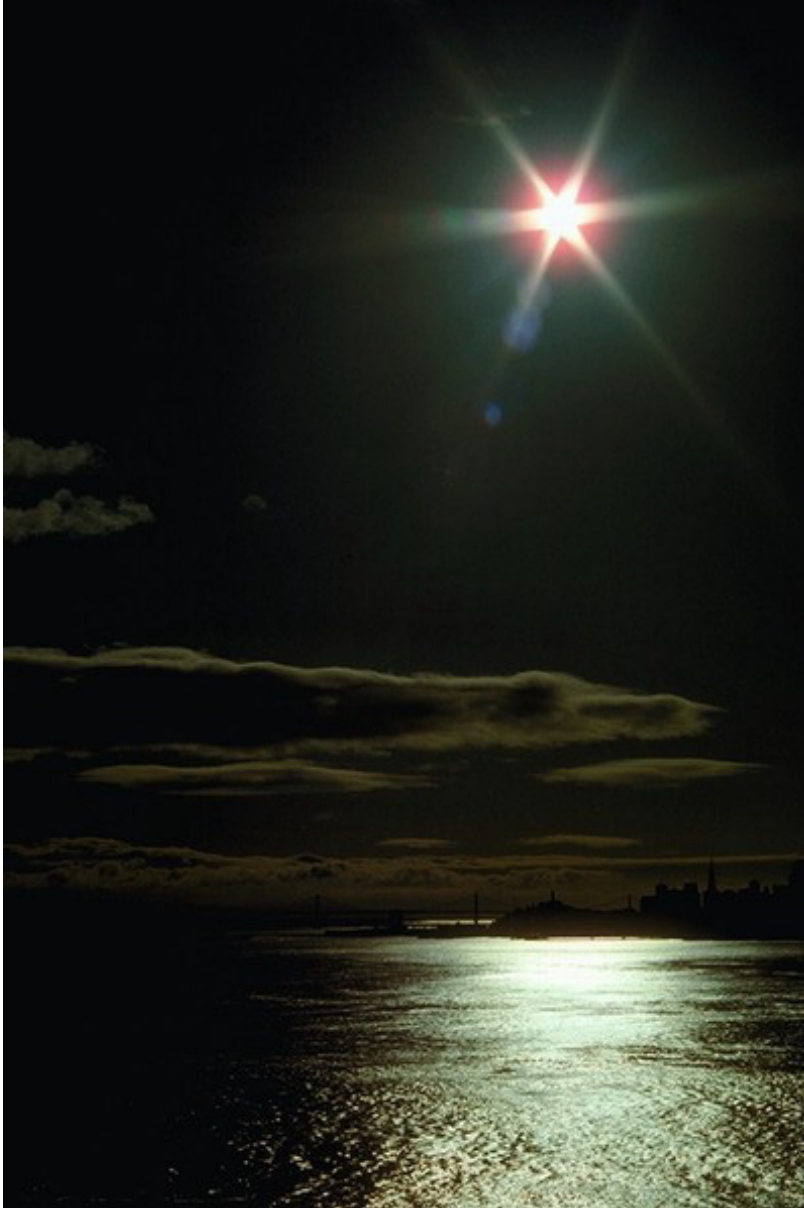
colonel
