- Copy of Sub Permit from KCSOS or CTC and "Information Necessary for Sub Teaching" Form from KSCSOS
- Physical Form
- TB Test Results
- Department of Justice Fingerprint Clearance from KCSOS
- Certificate of Completion for Mandated Reporter Training (CANRA)

If selected you will be contacted to attend a mandatory substitute orientation.
